


The Alice Network by Kate Quinn


Homecoming by Kate Morton

A laid-off London journalist returns home to Sydney where she discovers a link between her family and an infamous 1959 crime.




Cloud Cuckoo Land by Anthony Doerr

Constantinople to the future, as they discover resourcefulness and hope amidst peril.




The Invisible Life of Addie Larue by V.E. Schwab
